

21 Days of Prayer

‘Call to me and I will answer you and tell you great and unsearchable things you do not know.’ (Jeremiah 33:3)

If my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and I will forgive their sin and will heal their land. (2 Chronicles 7:14)

We do not make requests of you because we are righteous, but because of your great mercy. ¹⁹ Lord, listen! Lord, forgive! Lord, hear and act! For your sake, my God, do not delay, because your city and your people bear your Name.” (Daniel 9:17-19)

Making the Most of Your Prayer Experience

1. Every day ask Jesus to fill you with the Holy Spirit, to speak to you and to guide your prayers (Luke 11:13, Romans 8:26-27, Ephesians 6:17)
2. Keep short accounts with God, confess your sins and live a cleansed life (Isaiah 59:1-2, Psalm 66:18, 1 John 1:9)
3. Listen to God before you pray (John 16:13-15)
4. As you journal your prayers with the 21 Day Prayer Devotions, also journal and keep track of answered prayer so that you can give thanks (1 Thessalonians 5:16-18)
5. Join the Prayer Gatherings so that you can be praying together with other believers (Matthew 18:18-20)
