### **God's Word on children and parenting**

**Genesis 1:26-28**

<sup>26</sup> Then God said, “Let us make man in our image, after our likeness. And let them have dominion over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the heavens and over the livestock and over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth.”

in the image of God he created him;

## **Old Testament Parenting Instructions**

### Deuteronomy 6

<sup>4</sup> “Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is one. <sup>5</sup> You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might. <sup>6</sup> And these words that I command you today shall be on your heart. <sup>7</sup> You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise. <sup>8</sup> You shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. <sup>9</sup> You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates.

### Proverbs 13:24

Whoever spares the rod hates his son, but he who loves him is diligent to discipline him.

### Proverbs 22:6

Train up a child in the way he should go; even when he is old he will not depart from it.

### Proverbs 23:13-14

<sup>13-14</sup> Don’t fail to correct your children; discipline won’t hurt them! They won’t die if you spank them! Punishment will keep them out of hell. (Living Bible)

### Proverbs 29:15

The rod and reproof give wisdom, but a child left to himself brings shame to his mother.

## **New Testament Parenting Instructions**

### Ephesians 6:4

<sup>4</sup> Fathers, don’t stir up anger in your children, but bring them up in the training and instruction of the Lord.

Colossians 3:21

<sup>21</sup> Fathers, do not provoke or irritate or exasperate your children [with demands that are trivial or unreasonable or humiliating or abusive; nor by favoritism or indifference; treat them tenderly with lovingkindness], so they will not lose heart and become discouraged or unmotivated [with their spirits broken]. (Amplified Version)

1 Thessalonians 2:7-12

Or we were like a mother feeding and caring for her own children. <sup>8</sup>We loved you so much that we shared with you not only God's Good News but our own lives, too... <sup>11</sup> And you know that we treated each of you as a father treats his own children. <sup>12</sup> We pleaded with you, encouraged you, and urged you to live your lives in a way that God would consider worthy. For he called you to share in his Kingdom and glory.
