



Awake: Radically Ordinary Part 2 | Galatians 5:25


Surrendering through Obedience by Faith


John 14:15-17

<u>Cultivating though Spiritual Practices</u>

1 Timothy 4:7-8

⁷ Have nothing to do with irreverent, silly myths. Rather train yourself for godliness; ⁸ for while bodily training is of some value, godliness is of value in every way, as it holds promise for the present life and also for the life to come.
