Luke 11:37-54 - "Revival is Right at the Door" (Jordan Gash)

"Give first the offering of the inward man. Give your heart, your affections, and your will to God, as the first great alms which you bestow, and then all your other actions, proceeding from a right heart, are an acceptable sacrifice, and a clean offering in the sight of God" -J.C. Ryle

We can experience revival when we respond to the revelation of Jesus Christ with repentance.

Woe #1: Revival gets held outside the door when we, the people of God, don't actively fight for love and justice.

Woe #2: Revival gets held outside the door when we, the people of God, seek to honor our own name rather than the name of Jesus.

Woe #3: Revival gets held outside the door when we, the people of God, teach God's word falsely.

Woe #4: Revival gets held outside the door when we, the people of God, [lack tender hearts for those we seek to reach.](#)

Woe #5: Revival gets held outside the door when we, the people of God, [aren't authentic.](#)

Woe #6: Revival gets held outside the door when we, the people of God, [withhold people from a knowledge of Jesus.](#)
