



Unstoppable Joy: 7 truths from the book of Philippians

Rejoice in the Lord Always!

(Philippians 3:1) Further, my brothers and sisters, **rejoice** in the Lord! It is no trouble for me to write the same things to you again, and it is a safeguard for you.

(Philippians 4:4) **Rejoice** in the Lord always. I will say it again: **Rejoice!**

(1 Chronicles 16:27) Splendor and majesty are before him; strength and **joy** are in his dwelling place.

(1 Chronicles 16:10) Glory in his holy name; let the hearts of those who seek the Lord **rejoice**.

(Nehemiah 8:10) Nehemiah said, "Go and enjoy choice food and sweet drinks, and send some to those who have nothing prepared. This day is holy to our Lord. Do not grieve, for the **joy** of the Lord is your strength."

(Psalm 16:11) You make known to me the path of life; you will fill me with **joy** in your presence, with eternal pleasures at your right hand.

(Psalm 13:5) But I trust in your unfailing love; my heart **rejoices** in your salvation.

(Psalm 81:1) Sing for **joy** to God our strength; shout aloud to the God of Jacob!

(Psalm 68:3) But may the righteous be glad and rejoice before God; may they be happy and **joyful**.

(Psalm 119:14) I **rejoice** in following your statutes as one **rejoices** in great riches.

(Luke 10:20) However, do not **rejoice** that the spirits submit to you, but **rejoice** that your names are written in heaven.”

(John 15:11) I have told you this so that my **joy** may be in you and that your **joy** may be complete.

(Acts 16:34) The jailer brought them into his house and set a meal before them; he was filled with **joy** because he had come to believe in God—he and his whole household.

(Romans 14:17) For the kingdom of God is not a matter of eating and drinking, but of righteousness, peace and **joy** in the Holy Spirit,

(Galatians 5:22) But the fruit of the Spirit is love, **joy**, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness,

(James 1:2) Consider it pure **joy**, my brothers and sisters, whenever you face trials of many kinds,

(3 John 1:4) I have no greater **joy** than to hear that my children are walking in the truth
