

Finding Joy in Influencing Others for Christ

I. Seeing the joy <u>principle</u>

Philippians 1

²¹ For to me, to live is Christ, and to die is gain. ²² But if *I am* to live *on* in the flesh, this *will mean* fruitful labor for me; and I do not know which to choose. ²³ But I am hard-pressed from both *directions*, having the desire to depart and be with Christ, for *that* is very much better; ²⁴ yet to remain on in the flesh is more necessary for your sakes. ²⁵ Convinced of this, I know that I will remain and continue with you all for your progress and joy in the faith,

Philippians 4

Therefore, my beloved brothers *and sisters*, whom I long *to see*, my joy and crown, stand firm in the Lord in this way, my beloved.

1 Thessalonians 2

¹⁹ For who *is* our hope, or joy or crown of pride, in the presence of our Lord Jesus at His coming? Or *is it* not indeed you? ²⁰ For you are our glory and joy.

1 Thessalonians 3:7-9

⁷ Therefore, brothers and sisters, in all our distress and persecution we were encouraged about you because of your faith. ⁸ For now we really live, since you are standing firm in the Lord. ⁹ How can we thank God enough for you in return for all the joy we have in the presence of our God because of you?

3 John

⁴I have no greater joy than to hear that my spiritual children are walking in the truth.

Why does this give us joy?

- II. How can we influence others for Christ and experience the joy of the Lord
- 1. We experience joy in <u>praying</u> for others (Philippians 1:3-5)
- 2. We experience joy in sharing <u>our hearts and lives</u> with others (1 Thessalonians 2:7-8)
- 3. We experience joy in being an <u>example</u> that others follow (1 Thessalonians 1:5-6)
- 4. We experience joy in giving <u>spiritual encouragement</u> to others (1 Thessalonians 3:7-9)
- 5. We experience joy in <u>mentoring</u> others to follow Christ (2 Timothy 1:3-5)

Applications

1. Embrace your identity as a salve of Jesus Christ

- 2. Proactively pray for the believers God has brought into your life
- 3. Take your relationship to a more heart-felt and transparent level
- 4. Be intentional in speaking words of spiritual encouragement
- 5. Ask God to reveal to you people for whom you are to be a <u>mentor</u> and initiate a discipleship relationship
- 6. Become a discipler of disciple-makers
