**OUR RESPONSE IN OUR RELATIONSHIPS**

Keep on loving each other as brothers and sisters. **Hebrews 13:1**

<sup>34</sup> So now I am giving you a new commandment: Love each other. Just as I have loved you, you should love each other. <sup>35</sup> Your love for one another will prove to the world that you are my disciples." **John 13:34-35**

<sup>2</sup> Don't forget to show **hospitality** to strangers, for some who have done this have entertained angels without realizing it! **Hebrews 13:2**

<sup>8</sup> Most important of all, continue to show deep love for each other, for love covers a multitude of sins.

<sup>9</sup> Cheerfully share your home with those who need a meal or a place to stay. **1 Peter 4:8-9**

<sup>4</sup> Give honor to marriage and remain faithful to one another in marriage. God will surely judge people who are immoral and those who commit adultery. **Hebrews 13:4**

**OUR RESPONSE TO OUR LEADERS**

<sup>7</sup> Remember your leaders who taught you the word of God. Think of all the good that has come from their lives and follow the example of their faith. **Hebrews 13:7**

<sup>17</sup> Obey your spiritual leaders and do what they say. Their work is to watch over your souls, and they are accountable to God. Give them reason to do this with joy and not with sorrow. That would certainly not be for your benefit. **Hebrews 13:17**

### OUR RESPONSE IN OUR PLACE

<sup>10</sup> We have an altar from which the priests in the Tabernacle have no right to eat. <sup>11</sup> Under the old system, the high priest brought the blood of animals into the Holy Place as a sacrifice for sin, and the bodies of the animals were burned outside the camp. <sup>12</sup> So also Jesus suffered and died outside the city gates to make his people holy by means of his own blood. <sup>13</sup> So let us go out to him, outside the camp, and bear the disgrace he bore. <sup>14</sup> For this world is not our permanent home; we are looking forward to a home yet to come.

### OUR RESPONSE IN OUR PRAISE

<sup>15</sup> Therefore, let us offer **through Jesus** a continual sacrifice of praise to God, proclaiming our allegiance to his name. <sup>16</sup> And don't forget to do good and to share with those in need. These are the sacrifices that please God.

<sup>11</sup> the voice of joy and the voice of gladness, the voice of the bridegroom and the voice of the bride, the voice of those who will say: "Praise the Lord of hosts, For the Lord *is* good, For His mercy *endures* forever"— *and* of those *who will* bring the sacrifice of praise into the house of the Lord. For I will cause the captives of the land to return as at the first,' says the Lord. **Jeremiah 33:11**

<sup>28</sup> Therefore, since we receive a kingdom which cannot be shaken, let's show gratitude, by which we may offer to God an acceptable service with reverence and awe; <sup>29</sup> for our God is a consuming fire. **Hebrews 12:28-29**

<sup>20</sup> Now may the God of peace—who brought up from the dead our Lord Jesus, the great Shepherd of the sheep, and ratified an eternal covenant with his blood—<sup>21</sup> may he equip you with all you need for doing his will. May he produce in you, through the power of Jesus Christ, every good thing that is pleasing to him. All glory to him forever and ever! Amen. **Hebrews 13:20-21**
