

The One Another's are for One Another

1. John 13:14

Now that I, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also should wash one another's feet.

2. John 13:34-35

³⁴ A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another, even as I have loved you, that you also love one another. ³⁵ By this all men will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another."

3. Romans 12:10

Be devoted to one another in brotherly love; give preference to one another in honor;

4. Romans 12:16

Be of the same mind toward one another; do not be haughty in mind, but associate with the lowly. Do not be wise in your own estimation.

5. Romans 13:8

Owe nothing to anyone except to love one another; for he who loves his neighbor has fulfilled *the* law.

6. Romans 14:13

Therefore let us not judge one another anymore, but rather determine this—not to put an obstacle or a stumbling block in a brother's way.

7. Romans 14:19

So then we pursue the things which make for peace and the building up of one another.

8. Romans 15:7

Therefore, accept one another, just as Christ also accepted us to the glory of God.

9. Galatians 5:13

For you were called to freedom, brethren; only *do* not *turn* your freedom into an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another.

10. Galatians 5:26

Let us not become boastful, challenging one another, envying one another.

11. Galatians 6:2

Bear one another's burdens, and thereby fulfill the law of Christ.

12. Ephesians 4:2

with all humility and gentleness, with patience, showing tolerance for one another in love,

13. Ephesians 4:32

Be kind to one another, tender-hearted, forgiving each other, just as God in Christ also has forgiven you.

14. Ephesians 5:19

speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody with your heart to the Lord;

15. Ephesians 5:21

and be subject to one another in the fear of Christ.

16. Philippians 2:3

Do nothing from selfishness or empty conceit, but with humility of mind regard one another as more important than yourselves;

17. Colossians 3:9

Do not lie to one another, since you laid aside the old self with its *evil* practices,

18. Colossians 3:13

bearing with one another, and forgiving each other, whoever has a complaint against anyone; just as the Lord forgave you, so also should you.

19. Colossians 3:16

Let the word of Christ richly dwell within you, with all wisdom teaching and admonishing one another with psalms *and* hymns *and* spiritual songs, singing with thankfulness in your hearts to God.

20. 1 Thessalonians 4:9

Now as to the love of the brethren, you have no need for *anyone* to write to you, for you yourselves are taught by God to love one another;

21. 1 Thessalonians 4:18

Therefore comfort one another with these words.

22. 1 Thessalonians 5:11

Therefore encourage one another and build up one another, just as you also are doing.

23. 1 Thessalonians 5:13

and that you esteem them very highly in love because of their work.

Live in peace with one another.

24. 1 Thessalonians 5:15

See that no one repays another with evil for evil, but always seek after that which is good for one another and for all people.

25. Hebrews 3:13

But encourage one another day after day, as long as it is *still* called "Today," so that none of you will be hardened by the deceitfulness of sin.

26. Hebrews 10:24

and let us consider how to stimulate one another to love and good deeds,

27. Hebrews 10:25

not forsaking our own assembling together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging *one another*, and all the more as you see the day drawing near.

28. James 4:11

Do not speak against one another, brethren. He who speaks against a brother or judges his brother, speaks against the law and judges the law; but if you judge the law, you are not a doer of the law but a judge of it.

29. James 5:9

Do not complain, brethren, against one another, so that you yourselves may not be judged; behold, the Judge is standing right at the door.

30. James 5:16

Therefore, confess your sins to one another, and pray for one another so that you may be healed. The effective prayer of a righteous man can accomplish much.

31. 1 Peter 1:22

Since you have in obedience to the truth purified your souls for a sincere love of the brethren, fervently love one another from the heart,

32. 1 Peter 4:8

Above all, keep fervent in your love for one another, because love covers a multitude of sins.

33. 1 Peter 4:9

Be hospitable to one another without complaint.

34. 1 Peter 4:10

As each one has received a *special* gift, employ it in serving one another as good stewards of the manifold grace of God.

35. 1 Peter 5:5

You younger men, likewise, be subject to *your* elders; and all of you, clothe yourselves with humility toward one another, for God is OPPOSED TO THE PROUD, BUT GIVES GRACE TO THE HUMBLE.

36. 1 John 3:11

For this is the message which you have heard from the beginning, that we should love one another;

37. 1 John 3:23

This is His commandment, that we believe in the name of His Son Jesus Christ, and love one another, just as He commanded us.

38. 1 John 4:7

Beloved, let us love one another, for love is from God; and everyone who loves is born of God and knows God.

39. 1 John 4:11

Beloved, if God so loved us, we also ought to love one another.

40. 2 John 1:5

Now I ask you, lady, not as though *I were* writing to you a new commandment, but the one which we have had from the beginning, that we love one another.

41. John 15:12

"This is My commandment, that you love one another, just as I have loved you.

42. Colossians 3:13

bearing with one another, and forgiving each other, whoever has a complaint against anyone; just as the Lord forgave you, so also should you.

Observations

- 1. The undeniable priority that God puts on people and realtionships
 - 2. You have to have another to obey the one another's
 - 3. The Christian life is other-centered
- 4. You can't be controlled by your feelings to obey these commands5. It will require supernatural help
 - 6. The command to love one another is repeated most often
