# 1. TRUST IN GOD'S FAITHFULNESS

## **Meditate on God's Promises**

<sup>5</sup> Keep your lives free from the love of money and be content with what you have, because God has said, "Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you."

Heb. 13:5

## **Reflect on Past Experiences**

He has delivered us from such a deadly peril, and he will deliver us again. On him we have set our hope that he will continue to deliver us. **2 Cor. 1:10** 

# Live by Faith, Not by Sight

For we live by faith, not by sight. 2 Corinthians 5:7

<sup>4</sup> Such confidence we have through Christ before God. <sup>5</sup> Not that we are competent in ourselves to claim anything for ourselves, <u>but our competence comes from God</u>. **2 Cor. 3:4-5**

#### 2. HOLD FAST TO SOUND TEACHING

### Staying Rooted in the Truth – Keeps us routed

So then, just as you received Christ Jesus as Lord, continue to live your lives in him, rooted and built up in him, strengthened in the faith as you were taught, and overflowing with thankfulness." **Colossians 2:6-7**

Guard: phulasso: Verb means "to guard," "to protect," or "to keep watch over.

# We guard what is valuable

<sup>7</sup>The law of the Lord is perfect, refreshing the soul. The statutes of the Lord are trustworthy, making wise the simple. <sup>8</sup>The precepts of the Lord are right, giving joy to the heart. The commands of the Lord are radiant, giving light to the eyes. <sup>9</sup>The fear of the Lord is pure, enduring forever.
