### The Sent Man Starts Conversations

“How, then, can they call on the one they have not believed in? And how can they believe in the one of whom they have not heard?” **Rom. 10:14**

<sup>26</sup> Now an angel of the Lord said to Philip, “Go south to the road—the desert road—that goes down from Jerusalem to Gaza.” <sup>27</sup> So he started out, and on his way he met an Ethiopian eunuch, an important official in charge of all the treasury of the Kandake (which means “queen of the Ethiopians”). This man had gone to Jerusalem to worship,<sup>28</sup> and on his way home was sitting in his chariot reading the Book of Isaiah the prophet. <sup>29</sup> The Spirit told Philip, “Go to that chariot and stay near it.” <sup>30</sup> Then Philip ran up to the chariot and heard the man reading Isaiah the prophet. “Do you understand what you are reading?” Philip asked. <sup>31</sup> “How can I,” he said, “unless someone explains it to me?” So he invited Philip to come up and sit with him. <sup>32</sup> This is the passage of Scripture the eunuch was reading: “He was led like a sheep to the slaughter, and as a lamb before its shearer is silent, so he did not open his mouth. <sup>33</sup> In his humiliation, he was deprived of justice. Who can speak of his descendants? For his life was taken from the earth.” <sup>34</sup> The eunuch asked Philip, “Tell me, please, who is the prophet talking about, himself or someone else?” <sup>35</sup> Then Philip began with that very passage of Scripture and told him the good news about Jesus. **Acts 8:26–35**

## A SENT MAN STARTS CONVERSATIONS

### STRATEGY

Be **REAL**

Don't **RUSH**

Ask **SIMPLE** questions

Don't **FORCE**

**LISTEN** well

Point to **JESUS**

### A SENT MAN FOLLOWS GOD'S **LEADING**

The Spirit told Philip, “Go to that chariot and stay near it.” **Acts 8:29**

The Lord makes firm the steps of the one who delights in him. **Ps. 37:23**

**Truth:** A Sent Man responds when God prompts him to move.

Where might God already be prompting you to step toward someone?

### A SENT MAN STARTS WITH A **QUESTION**

Let your conversation be always full of grace, seasoned with salt, so that you may know how to answer everyone. **Col. 4:6**

Then Philip ran up to the chariot and heard the man reading Isaiah the prophet. “Do you understand what you are reading?” **Acts 8:30**

### 5 QUESTIONS

Do you have any kind of spiritual beliefs?

Who is Jesus to you?

Do you believe in heaven or hell?

If you died right now, where would you go?

What you believe isn't true, would you want to know?

### WRITE IN YOUR OWN WORDS

Did you grow up around church?

What do you think about Jesus?

Do you think there's more after this life?

Where do you think you stand with God?

Would you want to know the truth?

**Truth:** A Sent Man opens doors with simple, intentional questions.

## A SENT MAN LISTENS AND **LEARNS**

Dear brothers and sisters, take note of this: Everyone should be quick to listen, slow to speak and slow to become angry, **Jam. 1:19**

Do you understand what you are reading? Philip asked. <sup>31</sup> “How can I,” he said, “unless someone explains it to me?” **Acts 8:31**

**Truth:** A Sent Man listens before he leads.

Do you tend to talk more or listen more in conversations?

## A SENT MAN LEADS PEOPLE TO **JESUS**

Then Philip began with that very passage of Scripture and told him the good news about Jesus. **Acts 8:35**

<sup>15</sup> He said to them, “Go into all the world and preach the gospel to all creation. <sup>16</sup> Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned. **Mark 16:15-16**

**Truth:** A Sent Man doesn’t just start conversations—he guides them to Jesus.

What is keeping you from a conversation that moves someone one step closer to Jesus?

**SENT MAN TRUTH:** A Sent Man starts conversations—trusting God to use simple moments to open hearts.
