Since we live by the Spirit, let us keep in step with the Spirit. **Gal. 5:25**

⁴⁶ Then they came to Jericho. As Jesus and his disciples, together with a large crowd, were leaving the city, a blind man, Bartimaeus (which means “son of Timaeus”), was sitting by the roadside begging. ⁴⁷ When he heard that it was Jesus of Nazareth, he began to shout, “Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!” ⁴⁸ Many rebuked him and told him to be quiet, but he shouted all the more, “Son of David, have mercy on me!” ⁴⁹ Jesus stopped and said, “Call him.” **Mark 10:46-49**

MARKS OF A MAN WHO IS FREE

FREE MEN **SHOW** PROOF

²² But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, ²³ gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law. **Gal. 5:22–23**

If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit. **John 15:5**

Free Man Truth: The Spirit produces what effort alone never can.

FREE **FOLLOW** GOD’S LEADING

²⁴ Those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. ²⁵ Since we live by the Spirit, let us keep in step with the Spirit. ²⁶ Let us not become conceited, provoking and envying each other. **Gal. 5:24-26**

For those who are led by the Spirit of God are the children of God. **Rom. 8:14**

Free Man Truth: Freedom is not a destination; it is a daily walk.

Q – What does it practically look like for a man to keep in step with the Spirit?

FREE MEN **RESTORE** OTHERS

Brothers and sisters, if someone is caught in a sin, you who live by the Spirit should restore that person gently. But watch yourselves, or you also may be tempted. ² Carry each other’s burdens, and in this way you will fulfill the law of Christ. ³ If anyone thinks they are something when they are not, they deceive themselves. ⁴ Each one should test their own actions. Then they can take pride in themselves alone, without comparing themselves to someone else, ⁵ for each one should carry their own load. **Gal. 6:1–5**

¹⁹ My brothers and sisters, if one of you should wander from the truth and someone should bring that person back,

²⁰ remember this: Whoever turns a sinner from the error of their way will save them from death and cover over a multitude of sins. **Jam. 5:19–20**

Free Man Truth: Free men help others get back on their feet instead of kicking them while they're down.

Q – Why is gentleness often difficult when confronting another man's sin?

FREE MEN **PLANT** SEEDS BUT SEE FRUIT

⁶ Nevertheless, the one who receives instruction in the word should share all good things with their instructor. ⁷ Do not be deceived: God cannot be mocked. A man reaps what he sows. ⁸ Whoever sows to please their flesh, from the flesh will reap destruction; whoever sows to please the Spirit, from the Spirit will reap eternal life. **Gal. 6:6–8**

Whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will also reap generously. **2 Cor. 9:6**

Free Man Truth: The direction of your life is determined by the seeds you plant today.

Q – What are some practical ways men sow to the flesh? Sow to the Spirit?

FREE MEN REFUSE TO QUIT

⁹ Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up. ¹⁰ Therefore, as we have opportunity, let us do good to all people, especially to those who belong to the family of believers. **Gal. 6:9–10**

And as for you, brothers and sisters, never tire of doing what is good. **2 Thes. 3:13**

Free Man Truth: Freedom leads to perseverance, purpose, and impact.
