Now the tax collectors and sinners were all gathering around to hear Jesus. ² But the Pharisees and the teachers of the law muttered, “This man welcomes sinners and eats with them.” ³ Then Jesus told them this parable: ⁴ “Suppose one of you has a hundred sheep and loses one of them. Doesn’t he leave the ninety-nine in the open country and go after the lost sheep until he finds it? ⁵ And when he finds it, he joyfully puts it on his shoulders ⁶ and goes home. Then he calls his friends and neighbors together and says, ‘Rejoice with me; I have found my lost sheep.’ ⁷ I tell you that in the same way there will be more rejoicing in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who do not need to repent. **Luke 15:1–7**

FOMO: The fear that something important is happening and you're not part of it.

THE ONE MATTERS

Jesus loves crowds but—pursues individuals. He calls us to see THE ONE who is missing and move toward him.

SEE THE ONE

Suppose one of you has a hundred sheep and loses one of them. Doesn’t he leave the ninety-nine in the open country and go after the lost sheep until he finds it? **Luke 15:4**

For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost. **Luke 19:10**

FOMO Truth: Our mission begins when we focus not only on the crowds, but also on individuals.

GO AFTER THE ONE

¹⁴ How, then, can they call on the one they have not believed in? And how can they believe in the one of whom they have not heard? And how can they hear without someone preaching to them? ¹⁵ And how can anyone preach unless they are sent? As it is written: “How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news!”

FOMO Truth: Love doesn't wait for people to come. Love moves toward them.

PURSUE RELENTLESSLY

Suppose one of you has a hundred sheep and loses one of them. Doesn't he leave the ninety-nine in the open country and go after the lost sheep until he finds it? **Luke 15:4**

Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up. **Gal. 6:9**

Truth: Faithful men don't quit pursuing people because the first invitation isn't accepted.

Q: Who in your life needs someone who refuses to give up on them?

CELEBRATE WHAT HEAVEN CELEBRATES

There will be more rejoicing in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who do not need to repent. **Luke 15:7**

Likewise, I tell you, there is rejoicing in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner who repents. **Luke 15:10**

FOMO Truth: One changed life is worth every prayer, every invitation, and every effort.

Q: How can we cultivate a perspective that values one soul the way heaven does?
